



HOW TO SIZE YOUR WRIST

Not sure what size your wrist is? Neither do we. Which is why we've created this little guide, so that the next time you purchase a watch, we'll have it ready to wear right away.

- First things first, you'll need to print out this document on a piece of A4-sized paper.
- Cut along the dotted line and place it on either your left or right wrist. Side Note: watches made to be worn on the right are called 'destro' watches, 'destro' being Italian for 'right'.
- Secure the guide comfortably around your wrist and note the measurement.
- If your reading is between two markers, we advise rounding up to the nearest 0.5 cm (14.3 cm would round up to 14.5 cm).
- If you wish to have your bracelet sized, please share this measurement with your watch specialist – they'd be more than happy to assist.
